Dear Grandmasters, Masters and Instructors;

Hotel reservations at Howard Johnson (formerly Imperial 400), 207 Broadway Street East. Phone for reservations 1-800-781-2268 or 1-306-783-6581. Mention "**Prairie Wildfire**" for the special rate. The rate is \$76.00 CDN plus taxes per night. Please reserve early as only 50 rooms have been set aside for the tournament and more rooms will have to be negotiated if the maximum is exceeded. The rooms are only held until Friday October 20th. Give me a call if you have problems with rooms.

Entry forms and entry fees must be received in Yorkton before Midnight Friday October 27th, 2006. All late entry forms will be subject to an additional \$10 late registration fee. Please ensure that all data is complete and accurate. Incomplete or grossly inaccurate data will be considered for the late fee. Palgwe patterns will be eligible for our American neighbours.

Please supply your own club with **chest protectors, head gear, mouthguard (mandatory) and all other required safety gear**. When you approach the inspection area you will need to have all of your required equipment with you to ensure speedy procession of the matches. Foot gear required for all 10 years and under sparring divisions. Hard shell protectors will be rejected. **Black belts caught by inspection with this gear will be disqualified!** WTF gloves allowed and optional, but socks will be rejected!

The **weigh-ins** are not to disqualify anyone but to ensure fair divisions for **All Competitors**. There will be weigh-ins Friday night only at Kee's Taekwondo, #9 Broadway Street West. Please confirm weigh-in procedure Friday night at the dojang.

Electronic Scoring will be used in four matted rings for all belts.

Photo ID Cards will be issued to facilitate the tournament process and leave all VIPs, coaches and athletes with a souvenir of the event. You must appear personally at the dojang on Friday night to get your photo taken and have your ID card issued.

A **meeting of coaches** is scheduled for Saturday morning to explain how our event will proceed so that your competitors can be informed of the staging process.

As an **incentive for instructors** we will be paying \$50 towards the instructor's hotel room with 10 or more students registered by the Friday October 20th deadline. Please designate the name that receives the room subsidy.

A **referee committee** will be selecting and overseeing the judges and referee's to be used throughout the day. Please fill out and return the form for those interested in officiating. The referee committee chairman will assign you to teams for rotation between judging and rest. Referees and corner judges will receive free meals and a stitched Polo-shirt. Experienced center referees will receive an honourarium.

A **Poomse judging and performance Seminar** is planned for Friday November 3rd at the Kee's Taekwondo dojang. **The Seminar will be for black belts only.** Please fill out these forms and submit by Friday October 28th. Confirm via email of your intent to participate.

- Poomsae Seminar An introduction to WTF Standardized Poomsae Seminar is planned for Friday November 4th at the Kee's Taekwondo dojang. The Seminar will be conducted by SASK WTF Poomsae Committee Chair, Master Duk Ha, and will include the latest interpretations. Please fill out these forms and submit by Friday October 27th. Poomsae Judges that attend this seminar will receive priority selection status for the 2006 Prairie Wildfire Taekwondo Challenge.
- Poomsae Competition The Poomsae competition list will be posted on the wall and your instructor will also have a copy. You will be able to see what ring you will be called to and the name of your division. Please listen for the announcer to call your division and name so that you can respond and be prepared. There will be no changing of divisions following the setup on Friday night unless the Organizing committee incorrectly recorded the information from your entry form. You will perform the pattern that you designated on your entry form.
- Sparring Matches The fight trees and fight numbers will be posted on the wall around 11:00 AM. There will be no lining up of competitors. You divisions will be decided by weight., belt, age and gender. The match numbers shall be assigned to one of 4 rings as an opening becomes available. The fight number for the match in progress will be displayed at each ring.
- Match procedure When your name is called you will report to inspection with all of your required gear on and your ID card. You will be inspected and assigned to a staging chaperone. The staging chaperone will take the matched competitors and their fight number sheet to the on deck chairs or double deck chairs at ring side once the ring is assigned. Following the match the winner reports to the head table to ensure correct recording of the match results. From here the winner will be escorted by a chaperone to the records table to receive instructions regarding their next match. Win or lose please exit via the "Records Desk" exit.
